

Camping & Lodging Rules

At the Canoe Outpost, we want everyone's stay with us to be fun. To help ensure the enjoyment and safety of all, please abide by the following rules for your stay. During special events and dates or when large groups have rented out the entire property, special rules and expectations may apply. Violations of any rules may result in eviction from the property with no refund of fees paid. Please contact us if you have a special need or concern.

Prohibited items: Aerial fireworks, all firearms

Quiet Times: For the enjoyment of all guests, please observe quiet time between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. unless previous arrangements have been made with the office. No generators should be run during quiet times.

Noise: Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m., please limit your noise so as not to interfere with the enjoyment of others. Remember, just because you like Beethoven and the Beastie Boys does not mean that the folks camping next to you do.

Alcohol: The outpost is private property and we do allow responsible alcohol consumption. If you choose to drink, please do so responsibly.

Pets: We are pet friendly and welcome responsible pet owners with people & pet friendly pets with prior approval at the time of reservation. As long as no one objects, your pets may roam free on the property but you may be asked to put your pets on a leash if objections arise. Please be sure pick up after your pet. Remember that the river and the highway may be hazardous for your pet. We cannot be responsible for your pet so please DO NOT leave a pet unattended unless properly provided for, you are sure that they will not be a nuisance to other guests and you check with the office first. You are responsible for your pets and their actions.

Fires and firewood: Campfires are allowed in the camping area group fire pit or the fire rings in the camping or cabin areas only. Fire should be sized to their ring or pit and no more than 4' high. Firewood may be purchased from the office, brought with you or dead fallen wood may be collected from the property grounds. DO NOT cut any live trees.

Vehicles: Vehicles are limited to roadways and individual campsites. No vehicles in the group camp area without special arrangement.

Motorized carts or cycles: Only golf carts are allowed on the property and on our limited trails without special arrangement. No ATV's or dirt bikes.

Bicycles: Bicycles are welcome. Since we have dirt roads and very limited rough woods trails, you may find few places to use them at the outpost. Please ask our staff about bike trails in the area.

Private Facilities & Areas: We are happy to have you stay with us and we invite you to explore the river and land around us. However, we ask your cooperation in respecting that the area surrounding our house on the top of the hill is reserved for private family use.

Damages: All lodgers and campers are legally and financially responsible for their actions and any damages they may cause to property. Please act responsibly.
